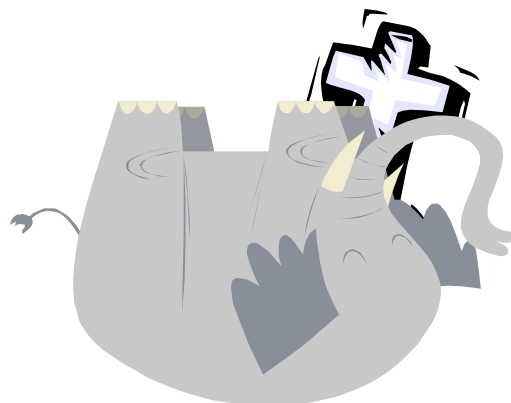
In literacy, our work will be based around spooky stories. We will be concentrating on decimal place value and problem solving in maths, and science will be focussed on dissolving and chemical changes.
