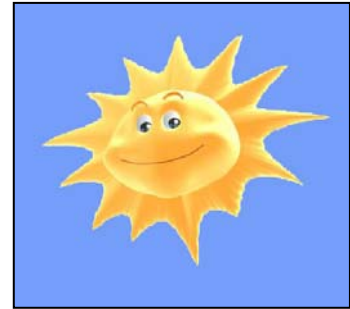


KINGS' FOREST PRIMARY SCHOOL
