Term 6

Our termly topic will be '**Landscapes**'. The pupils will help us to plan their own ideas but there will be a large art and geography theme throughout.

Each class will have two sessions of PE per week so your child needs their full PE kit in school everyday as these sessions are changeable. Class 11 will be continuing their swimming lessons from Thursday 17th June.

During our literacy hours we will be finishing the year with a final blast of narrative and fiction writing.

Numeracy work will include a focus on problem solving and using spreadsheets to enable ICT to help with our maths working. We still give our pupils time to develop their times table recall and mental calculation methods and would appreciate this to continue at home.

Science learning will explore the human body, linking to a focus on health by studying the heart, lungs and teeth.

Homework

Your child will receive weekly spellings and a weekly spellings test. It is very important that your child reads and practises spelling vocabulary every night. As well as this, your child will get a weekly piece of maths homework. We appreciate your support in the final leg of this important year.

Mrs Curtis will be teaching each class for one afternoon or morning per week.
