### NITS!

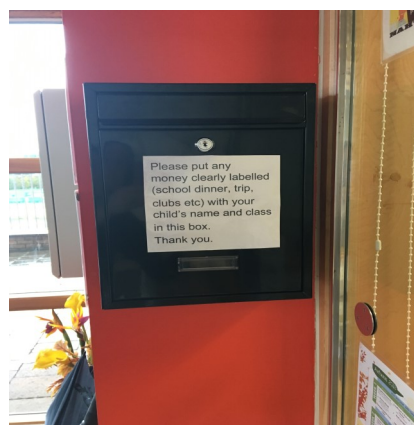
Please check your child's head regularly for head lice as they are extremely common in young children.
