Reading at Home

Dear parents and carers,

The children are enjoying our new library set up. A big thank you to Mrs Gray, Mr Jeans, Mrs Ryemill, Miss Ball and Mrs Tucker for helping create this wonderful space. It is great to see so many children eager to visit the school library.



We have now labelled our books with two different stickers. 'Read to you' books are Accelerated Reader/Phonics books that we expect the children to read to you at home. 'Read with me' books are those that you can share together. The children will bring one of each home every week.

Our library is now home to a beautiful reading tree that has been decorated by Mrs Hatton. Unfortunately, the tree is currently missing some leaves! This year, we are going to focus on celebrating reading at home. Each time your child reads to you, please ensure that you sign their planner. **We expect children to read to an adult at home at least three times a week.** You may write a short comment about their reading if you wish. The more times they read at home, the more leaves we can get on our tree! The leaves will be awarded as follows.



- 30, 60 & 90 reads at home = A reading certificate and a **green leaf** with their name on.
- 120 reads at home = Bronze reading certificate and a **bronze leaf** with their name on.
- 150 reads at home = Silver reading certificate and a **silver leaf** with their name on.
- 180 reads at home = Gold reading certificate and **gold leaf** with their name on.

The children will receive their reading certificate and leaf in our virtual assembly. They will then take their leaf and put it on the tree in the library.
