Including Nativity plays and Christmas concerts.



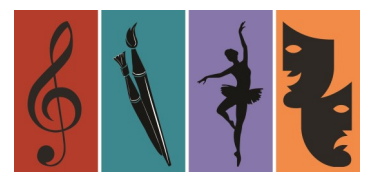
January: New starts and changing behaviours

What does it mean to make a new start and how can we improve and change .



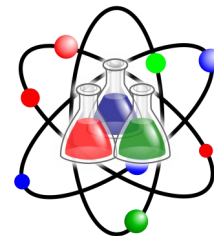
February: How have The Arts shaped Britain?

May: Feeling nervous!

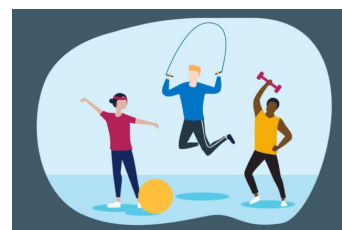
It is normal to feel anxious at times and there are things that can help.
