Year 6 visit to the Lifeskills Centre

The Year 6's will be visiting "Lifeskills - Learning for Living" safety education centre in Bristol on **Friday 13th October**. Pupils will have the opportunity to experience a number of real life situations and learn about how to make their lives safer.

Each year Lifeskills educates over 10,000 children from across the area and is supported by each of the local authorities, emergency services and primary care trusts.
